THE OPPOSITION

Club History

The club came into being in 1996 with the new club joining the Greater London Women's League. They then switched to the Essex County Women's league and one the division one title in the 2000/01 season. The club record for goals scored was also set that season with Lisa Robin's netting 46.

Ex Spurs player Kim Coster took over the running of the club in the 2002/03 season and the club saw three promotions under her leadership. The club also won the Essex County League cup in the 2003/04 season.

The club moved to the Eastern Region Women's League, finishing as runners-up in 2013, 2015 and 2016 going on to win it in 2018. In the 2018/19 season thy would finish second in the FA Women's National League Division 1 South East, their highest ever league finish at the time.

The clubs record win of 31 goals to nil also occurred in that season in a game against Rayleigh Town. They went on to win the Essex Women's Cup that season also. The club have done fairly well in the FA cup, being knocked out on penalties by Coventry United, (the team Rugby Borough was formerly known as) a few seasons ago.

The club got promoted into the FA Women's National league Southern Premier Division in the 2021/22 season and have stayed in it since.
