# Sporting Khalsa Women

## Club History



Members of FA Women's National League Northern Division.

Sporting Khalsa Women and Girls was established in 2015 following the merger with FC Reedswood founded in 2004. The Women's Section continues to be overseen by Chairwoman and founder Kelly Williams.

We currently have a thriving girls section, two senior sides competing in the FAWNL and 7v7 Women's Midweek Floodlight League Side. We also run a Wildcats Centre for girls 5-11 years old and have SQUAD programme for 12-14 year olds.

The club achieved promotion and won the Staffordshire Women's County Cup in their 20th anniversary year and now embark in our first season in Tier 3.

2024/25 season saw the Queens finish in a creditable 10th place with a comfortable cushion above the drop zone and finishing 1 point behind 7th place.

We also reached the Staffordshire Women's County Cup final again, but lost out narrowly to Stoke City Women.

The season was an end of an era as Manager Andy Mulligan made the tough decision to step down. In the close season 1st team coach Juan Dupazo was appointed 1st team manager and aims to carry on Andy's excellent work and move the club further forward.

Home fixtures are played at the Guardian Warehousing Arena on Sunday afternoons.

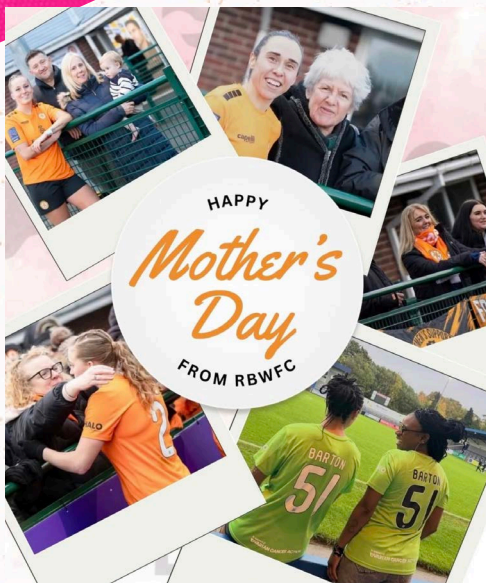

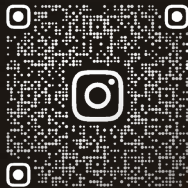

# mogan mogan

Guaranteed Fundraising Success

This weekend, Mogan & Mogan, a fundraising company that has been operating for 30 years, is sponsoring Rugby Borough's huge clash with league leaders Burnley. We sat down with Michael Morgan to discuss the company's journey and to find out more about their involvement with the club.

"The reason we're part of Rugby Borough is because my daughters did a crowdfunder three years ago to help save Coventry United, which of course has now become Rugby Borough. We were already in love with the club, we became even more so and still are now and follow them passionately.

I'll be sponsoring Coventry City the day before the match and we'll be on the pitch, but I'm a great believer in backing women's sports too and we love the people at Rugby Borough. Some of the players are great friends to my daughters and are role models.

In terms of my hopes for the game- I want a victory. There is a dream to get back to the second tier and I think that dream is very possible and we're going to do all we can to help, and we hope the community will rally.

It means the world for us to sponsor in women's sport. I think for teenage girls and for younger girls, ladies like Katy, Alana and Malika are role models and heroes- inspiring the next generation of children to play their own roles in sports. So, we're doing this to encourage others and because we think we might win and we're doing this to give the Borough a great chance of fulfilling all of our dreams by getting promoted."

Cyber security firm joins forces with Borough to champion women's football & community

The business owner also has a strong footballing background. The former semi-professional footballer recalled his early playing days and spoke on his connection with Borough's current manager Lee Burch.

"I used to play for Lee Burch when he was starting his coaching days in Southampton. One day he saw me playing in the park and he said come play for me, so I used to play semi-professional standard. So, I do have a proper footballing background." The footballing connection, combined with a belief in the values of women's football and community engagement, made Rugby Borough an ideal club for Kudee Ltd to collaborate with.

Olabiyi reflected on the new one-year sponsorship deal.



He added: "I've been watching Rugby and looking at Lee Burch's Instagram posts and I've seen his journey all the way as well. I think you can see the club is growing and after my conversations with Max Turner (Chief Operating Officer), it seems more like a family and a community club and that is something that Kudee Ltd is all about.

"We also sponsor other local teams in Crawley where we are based, and we want to be part of something big. We know women's football needs more visibility as well and I've got two daughters who are crazy about football. I want to sponsor a club that has values and Rugby definitely has those."

Olabiyi said: "I was buzzing when I saw that Rugby had beat Arsenal and I spoke to Max about it. For me it's more personal than business orientated, as regardless I was always supporting the club before this sponsorship.

"I'm hoping it doesn't stop here, regardless of who's the gaffer or who's running the club and I'm hoping we can build from there and hopefully we can provide support where needed and help the club get even bigger. We will be there to support and not just offering one-off support, we want it to be a continuous relationship.

"Based on the results, I've been really proud of the team and over the weekend I think the team were unlucky with the 2-2 draw. We're hoping for more positive results and hope the club has a very successful season."

The partnership marks an exciting step for both Rugby Borough Women FC and Kudee Ltd, uniting two organisations that share a passion for growth, innovation, and community spirit.
