Halifax Womens F.C

History



Club History Halifax FC Women were formed in 2013 as Brighthouse Town Ladies. Current manager Rob Mitchell, helped set the club up and guided the club from tier 6 to tier 3 where they play in the FA Womens National League Northern Premier Division.

In the first season 'Town' managed to complete an unbeaten season winning the NERWFL Southern Division. This was followed up by a runners-up spot behind Hull City after in the NERWFL Premier Division alongside lifting the League Cup.

The team went one better the following season, Halifax would lift the title after another unbeaten season. The team would also reach the final of the West Riding County Cup eventually losing out to then tier 3 side Bradford City.

FA Cup runs to the third and fourth rounds followed with glamour ties against WSL sides Sunderland and Everton, giving the club a taste of what could be with the club now competing in the FA Womens National League Northern Division One alongside the likes of Newcastle United, Leeds United and Burnley.

The next two seasons saw consecutive second place finishes to Hull City and then Burnley which saw the club establish themselves as one of the stronger teams in the league.

Following the COVID pandemic the FA announced that promotion would be awarded to any club who could submit a long term development plan as well as other criteria relating to sporting merit. The club was successful and was awarded promotion and would therefore compete in the FA Womens National League Northern Premier Division for the first time in their history.

Two County Cup wins in successive seasons as well as a very respectable 7th place finish was followed up by a 5th place finish the following season.

In the summer of 2023, the club rebranded as Halifax FC Women and became completely independent and self funded. A strong second half of the 2023/24 season saw wins against Wolves and Nottingham Forest and a point against Champions Newcastle United helping the club finish in a respectable 6th place. The club would end the season by winning another County Cup with victory over Leeds Mods. The 2024/25 season finished with another County Cup final, this time losing on penalties to winners Leeds United.

Guaranteed Fundraising Success

In terms of my hopes for the game- I want a victory. There is a dream to get back to the second tier and I think that dream is very possible and we're going to do all we can to help, and we hope the community will rally.

It means the world for us to sponsor in women's sport. I think for teenage girls and for younger girls, ladies like Katy, Alana and Malika are role models and heroes- inspiring the next generation of children to play their own roles in sports. So, we're doing this to encourage others and because we think we might win and we're doing this to give the Borough a great chance of fulfilling all of our dreams by getting promoted."

"I used to play for Lee Burch when he was starting his coaching days in Southampton. One day he saw me playing in the park and he said come play for me, so I used to play semi-professional standard. So, I do have a proper footballing background." The footballing connection, combined with a belief in the values of women's football and community engagement, made Rugby Borough an ideal club for Kudee Ltd to collaborate with.

Olabiyi reflected on the new one-year sponsorship deal.



He added: "I've been watching Rugby and looking at Lee Burch's Instagram posts and I've seen his journey all the way as well. I think you can see the club is growing and after my conversations with Max Turner (Chief Operating Officer), it seems more like a family and a community club and that is something that Kudee Ltd is all about.

"We also sponsor other local teams in Crawley where we are based, and we want to be part of something big. We know women's football needs more visibility as well and I've got two daughters who are crazy about football. I want to sponsor a club that has values and Rugby definitely has those."

"I'm hoping it doesn't stop here, regardless of who's the gaffer or who's running the club and I'm hoping we can build from there and hopefully we can provide support where needed and help the club get even bigger. We will be there to support and not just offering one-off support, we want it to be a continuous relationship.

"Based on the results, I've been really proud of the team and over the weekend I think the team were unlucky with the 2-2 draw. We're hoping for more positive results and hope the club has a very successful season."

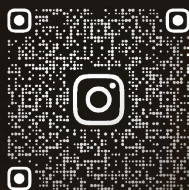
